

Community Health Network Pharmacy Practice & Specialty Residency

Community Health Network is a 5-hospital healthcare provider located in the greater Indianapolis, Indiana area. The network offers two (2) ASHP accredited Pharmacy Practice Residency positions and one (1) Primary Care specialty residency position. These one-year programs are available from July 1 through June 30 annually.

Training opportunities include experiences in drug information, general medicine, ambulatory care, behavioral & mental health, practice management, critical care, oncology and cardiology with other electives available. The resident will concentrate their experience time between the North, East and Heart Hospital campuses.

The residency experience is affiliated with Butler University College of Pharmacy. A strong desire to gain academic and teaching experience is offered via this collaboration. Residents will be included in a number of academic roles and mentorship activities.

The residents are involved in all aspects of pharmacy practice including: performance improvement, journal club, research projects, on-call activities and student precepting.

The residents are eligible for full network pharmacist benefits such as health insurance, paid time off, travel expenses and use of a personal digital assistant (PDA). An annual stipend of \$ 38,000 is offered.

Candidates must have a PharmD degree from an accredited college of pharmacy and be eligible for licensure in Indiana. Candidates will participate in the National Matching Program. Applications are accepted between December 1 and January 30 each year. Applications should include a letter of interest, an official copy of college transcripts, CV, and three (3) letters of recommendation.
