Pharmacy Education Foundation “Joseph E. McSoley Scholarship”

On July 25, 1996 the pharmacy community and many individuals lost a good friend. Joseph E. McSoley passed away, only a day after taking the IPA staff out to lunch. It was always Joe's turn to pay, according to him, and now it is our turn to repay Joe for all he contributed to us in his life. Joe was a long time supporter of the Indiana Pharmacists Association and had been involved on the Board of Directors of the association since 1953. He was President of IPA in 1967 and had served as treasurer of the IPA from 1970 to 1995. Joe also found the time to serve his church. He had been a member of the Board and a Deacon at Allisonville Christian Church and taught a children's Sunday School class at 91st Street Christian Church. Joe served his community and his profession on so many boards and volunteer positions it is impossible to list them all here.

The 1996 recipient of the Joseph E. McSoley Pharmacist of the Year Award, Winnie Landis, announced the creation of the Pharmacists Education Foundation Scholarship at the 1996 Annual Meeting of the Indiana Pharmacists Association. The first awards were presented during the 1998 Spring Meeting of the Indiana Pharmacists Alliance in Indianapolis. The award consists of two \$2,000 scholarships, one each to be awarded to a Butler student and to a Purdue Student each year.
